## St. Thomas The Apostle

Apostle Thomas was one of the disciples of Jesus who took the Great Commission (Matt. 28:18-20) seriously and decided to move to the ends of the earth with the light of the Gospel. Thomas left for India. According to the tradition he reached Cragannore at the Malabar coast in 52 C.E. According to the tradition he established seven churches at

- 1. Carangannore (Malankara)
- 2. Chavakad (Palur)
- 3. Parur near Alwaye
- 4. Gokamangalam
- 5. Niranam
- 6. Nilakkal (Chayal)
- 7. Quilon (Kalyan)



It is believed that St. Thomas then continued his mission and reached the east cost of India and died a martyr's deatha a place called 'St. Thomas Mount', and he was buried a Mylapore in Madras (Chennai). The remains were later taken to Edessa.

There are two days set apart to celebrate the legacy of St. Thomas in the church calendar. St. Thomas Day is celebrated on **July 3rd** and Sabha Dinam on **December 21**, the former is the feast commemorating the entombment of the remains at Edessa, and the latteris celebrated as the Day of Martyrdom.

The seven churches which were founded by St. Thomas began to grow slowly. The Christians came to be known as "Nazranikal" (followers of the man of Nazareth).
